UK ATHLETICS RULE 107 APPLIES TO ALL AGE GROUPS

THERE MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 3 ENTRIES PER EVENT AND WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL AN EVENT IF ENTRIES FALL BELOW THIS NUMBER.

Birth/Residence qualification is in one of the following:

Avon, Herefordshire, Gloucestershire, Leicestershire, Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire, Shropshire, Staffordshire, Warwickshire, Worcestershire. NB: England South West & East Midlands are recognised for qualification purposes BUT you can only compete in one Area Championships in a calendar year – January to December.

NB: The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries and revise dates where necessary.

PLEASE NOTE: ENTRIES MAY BE RESTRICTED DUE TO EXCESSIVE NUMBERS.
